## WHERE SHOULD I STAY?

We have secured discounted rates at a number of good-reputed hotels in central London, including the Summit host hotel, London Hilton on Park Lane. ## WHAT ABOUT TRANSPORT?

If you have a contactless bank card, you can use it to pay for public transport, whether it's trains, buses or the underground. Otherwise, you can purchase an Oyster card (the London card for public transport) and either top your credit up as you go or pay for a weekly ticket.

You might also hear of the Visitor Pass – this is only valid for travelling during off-peak hours so it might not be suitable to travel to our events during the Week of Women.

## WHAT IF I NEED A VISA?

If you do require a visa to visit the UK, we encourage you to apply as early as you can. We can provide a letter of support for your application, provided that you have already booked your ticket to the Summit and want to take part in the Week of Women events. To issue the letter, we will need:

- Your name as it appears on your passport
- Passport number
- Issue date and expiry date
- Date of birth
- Address
- Any other details specified by your country's authorities
